- i ) Applicants must be enrolled at overseas universities
- ii ) Applicants must have Language Proficiency as below:  
To have sufficient Japanese language for the course you wish to take. Also for the N5 and N4 level courses, applicants are required to have English language sufficiency.
- iii ) Applicants must have an environment for the online classes (ZOOM)

## 3. Maximum capacity of the Program: 50 students (10 for each course)

### i ) N5 Level Course① (Roman Character Class) :

This course is for those who have never studied Japanese before.

If there is more than one applicant for one course level, please provide the priority order on the Nomination Sheet.
- ii) submit the Certificate of Enrollment (in English), which is issued by his/her home university, through the online application.

## 6. Participant Selection

The selection result will be informed to applicant's home university via email by June 16.

## 7. Payment Deadline of the Participation Fee

Along with the selection result, the payment method of the program fee will be informed. Please note that participant must complete the procedure for overseas remittance by June 23.

\*Fees for remittance shall be borne by the participant.
